

Summary of the third Monitoring Committee meeting

The **Monitoring Committee (MC)** of the Interreg IPA Romania-Serbia Programme ensures the **effectiveness** and **quality** of the **implementation** of the Programme, has specific tasks related to the monitoring of the Programme, and consists of representatives from the two participating countries in the Programme, Romania and Serbia.

The **third Monitoring Committee meeting** of the **Interreg IPA Romania-Serbia Programme** was organised in an online format on the **15th of September, 2023**. The Monitoring Committee approved the **large infrastructure projects** to be financed from the Interreg IPA Romania-Serbia Programme.

The project approved under Priority 1: Environmental protection and risk management, **RORS00005, “A more secure cross-border area by enhancing the emergency response capability”**, having as its **Lead Partner** the **Romanian General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations**, aims to increase the safety and protection of the population, by improving the intervention capacity of emergency professional services and local communities in the cross-border area.

The project approved under Priority 2: Social and economic development, **RORS00013, “Early Diagnosis - Living Well with Dementia”**, having as **Lead Partner** the **Special Hospital for Psychiatric Diseases “Dr Slavoljub Bakalovic” Vrsac**, will be dedicated to increasing the access of the rural population to quality medical services in the field of early detection and treatment of cases of dementia.

The **two operations** approved for funding by the MC are asking for **€11,899,006.31**.
