

## Summary of the fourth Monitoring Committee meeting

The **Monitoring Committee** (MC) of the Interreg IPA Romania – Serbia Programme ensures the effectiveness and quality of the implementation of the Programme, has specific tasks related to the monitoring of the Programme and consists of representatives from the two participating countries in the Programme, Romania and Serbia.

The fourth Monitoring Committee of the Interreg IPA Romania-Serbia Programme was organized in a **hybrid format** on the **13<sup>th</sup> of December**, **2023**.

During the meeting the following topics were discussed:

- State of play of the Action Plans' implementation regarding the evaluations of the Interreg-IPA CBC Romania-Serbia Programme (2014-2020);
- the implementation and closure status of the Interreg-IPA CBC Romania-Serbia Programme (2014-2020);
- a report about the communication activities performed in 2023 in order to disseminate and capitalise the results of the projects financed by Interreg-IPA CBC Romania-Serbia Programme (2014-2020);
- **important aspects** about the Interreg IPA Romania-Serbia **Programme** (2021-2027) implementation status.

In addition, a brief discussion regarding the calendar of proposed events of the Interreg IPA Romania-Serbia (2021-2027) for the following year (2024), was initiated, including the next meeting of the Monitoring Committee and the closure Conference of the Interreg-IPA CBC Romania-Serbia Programme (2014-2020), and the European Commission representative informed the MC members about the status of post-2027 programming process.
