

Summary of the fifth Monitoring Committee meeting

The Monitoring Committee (MC) of the Interreg IPA Romania – Serbia Programme ensures the effectiveness and quality of the implementation of the Programme, has specific tasks related to the monitoring of the Programme and consists of representatives from the two participating countries in the Programme, Romania and Serbia.

The fifth Monitoring Committee meeting of the Interreg IPA Romania-Serbia Programme was organized in an online format on the 5th of September, 2024.

The Monitoring Committee approved list of projects (including the reserve list) from the 1st Call for proposals to be financed from the Interreg IPA Romania – Serbia Programme 2021-2027. **22 projects were selected for funding**, with a total value of **€30.4 million**, 9 projects with a total value of almost €13 million under Priority 1 and 13 projects with a total value of €17,4 million under Priority 2.

In addition, it was discussed the errata to the Methodology for using lump sums for project closure costs within the Interreg IPA CBC Romania-Serbia Programme (2021-2027) & Annex F - (Decision).
